

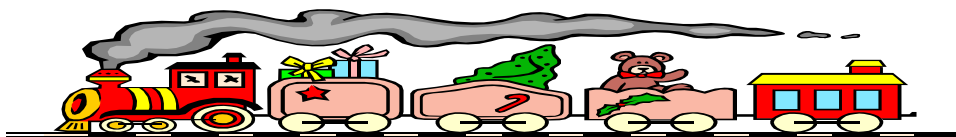

Ski trip flyers for the PSC trips are included in the Newsletter or may be found on the PSC website. At our regular club meetings Ski Trip Captains make brief trip presentations, and have tables set up with information, handouts and are prepared to accept deposits for reservations. Specific questions about any trip should be addressed to that trip's Captain.

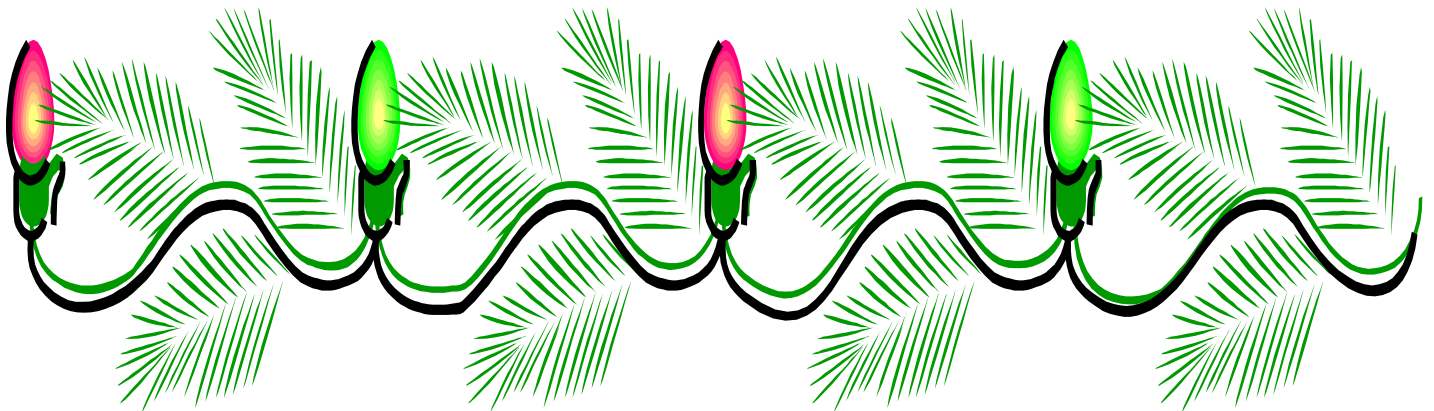
Because we strongly support our own trips and the efforts of our captains, naturally our first choice is to have the pleasure of your company on a PSC trip. However, PSC offers you another viable option to expand your choices. Because PSC is a member of the Blue Ridge Ski Council (BRSC), you are eligible for all of BRSC sanctioned trips at the same lodging and lift ticket price as the particular club sponsoring the trip (your transportation may alter total cost some). PSC website has link to BRSC. Another option is signing up for a Blue Ridge Ski Council Trip (see below).

If you are interested in Holiday Skiing (Dec 31 – Jan 3), the Richmond Ski Club is running a trip to Seven Springs, PA. Their Trip Captain (Karen.Noakes@aecom.com) has requested that our membership be made aware of this trip, which is BRSC sanctioned. That means you pay the same price as Richmond Ski Club members.

UN-SCHEDULED SKI OPPORTUNITIES: 'Last minute' additional ski trips may be arranged when "local" Blue Ridge skiing conditions are good. These will generally be one or two day trips to near-by resorts, for people with the flexibility to go on short notice. Contact Agnes Evans (867-8072) if you want to be on the list to be contacted for those opportunity trips.

PSC POLICY ON TRIP CANCELLATION FEE *

- For trips priced at \$100 or less, if no trip refund cut-off date is specified, fee is \$5 at any time before the trip. For other trips:
- \$25 up through the date of the September Membership Meeting.
- \$50 if after the September Meeting, but before the Trip Refund Cut Off Date.
- After the Trip Refund Cutoff Date, the canceling party is liable for any nonrecoverable trip cost incurred. In that case the individual will be charged whichever is the greater: the nonrecoverable trip cost incurred up to the time of cancellation or the applicable cancellation fee.

*(Cancellation Fees apply to cancellations made by the traveler. Not to those cancelled by the club).

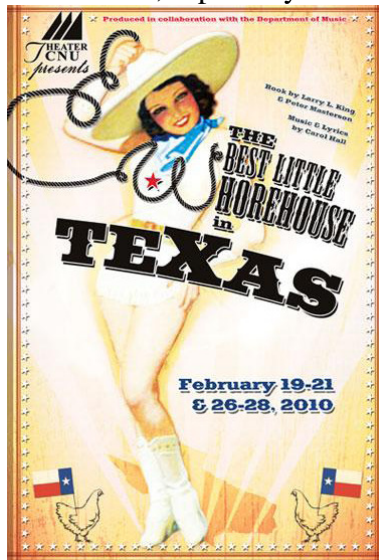

Join the Peninsula Ski Club (www.peninsulaskiclub.com) for our first trip to Taos Ski Valley, New Mexico. Founded in 1955 by Ernie Blake, Taos Ski Valley remains one of the few family owned and operated ski resorts in North America. The combination of dry desert climate and high elevation often provides skiers with radiant sunshine and lots of dry, light snow. With 49% green/blue terrain and the famous black diamond “steeps & deeps”, the mountain has trails to challenge all levels of ability. Our spacious condo lodging is only a snowballs throw from the #1 chairlift. **To sign up, send your name, address, phone number and email with your deposit check (written to the PSC) to the address at the bottom of this page.**

Price Includes: Round trip air to Albuquerque (see Airline below), transfers between airport and Taos Ski Valley with a stop in Santa Fe, 7 nights condominium lodging (2 per bedroom, see Lodging below), 5 days of lift tickets & lessons (see Lift Tickets below), wine & cheese welcome reception, dinner party at Snakedance Condos managers home, continental breakfast daily, 2 group dinners and pre-trip party.
