## PSC SKI TRIPS FOR 2012

As the newsletter goes to press, we are all looking forward to the great skiing opportunities the Peninsula Ski Club has to offer. We kick off the year with Sonny Short's trip to Steamboat, the land of deep snow and cowboy skiing. Cathy's increasingly popular outing to Wintergreen will be Jan 25-26 for those choosing an overnight stay and Jan 26 for the day trip. The day trip is a planned, impromptu (just show up) trip where you can bring your family and friends and introduce them to skiing and snowboarding. Then we have Jim Colbert's traditional trip to Mount Snow, now the Colbert's winter home, which has long been the PSC's most heavily attended trip. Next is Bill Bryan's trip to Snowbird and Alta, renowned for their deep, fluffy power. We wrap the year by reintroducing European Skiing to our lineup with Ronnie Triplett's trip to Andorra, which is a historic Principality in the Pyrenees Mountains, between France and Spain. ## Ski Utah's Wasatch Mountains

### Alta & Snowbird, UT ❄️ 25 Feb – 3 Mar 12

**ALTA** takes skiing seriously. No frills - just the best snow Utah has to offer! Located at the top of Little Cottonwood Canyon, Alta promises beautiful scenery and panoramic views from its slopes. Known for deep powder and a variety of awesome terrain, Alta provides skiing opportunities for every level of skier, including beginners. Alta is located 25 miles southeast of Salt Lake City, approximately 45 minutes from the Salt Lake City International Airport. It is one of the oldest ski resorts in the country, opening its first lift in 1939, and boasts an average annual snowfall of 540 inches. Note that Alta is one of three remaining ski resorts in America that prohibits snowboarders. Though widely respected as one of the most challenging of in-bounds ski areas in the world, Alta has always viewed itself as a family oriented ski area with its 2,200 acres of skiable terrain classified as 25% Beginner, 40% Intermediate, and 35% Advanced. The resort currently has 2 detachable quad chairs, 1 detachable triple chair, 1 triple chair [fixed grip], 3 double chairs, 3 surface tows, and a moving conveyor. **Ski magazine ranks Alta number 8 for Terrain Variety, 5 for Scenery, 3 for Weather, and number 1 for Snow and Overall Satisfaction!**

**SNOWBIRD** shares the canyon with Alta, its neighbor to the east. Beginning in the winter of 2002, both resorts began offering a joint pass allowing skiers to fully access all of the terrain on both mountains. Snowbird has 3,240 feet of continuously skiable vertical and 2,500 acres of terrain for everyone -- from wide bowls to gladed tree runs, from steep chutes to gentle cruising boulevards. Intermediates will want to checkout Chip's Run, the longest designated run at 2.5 miles. All this snow and terrain is easily accessible via eight chairlifts and one powerful aerial tram, which carries 125 passengers to the summit of 11,000-foot Hidden Peak in eight short minutes. Snowbird currently has 11 ski lifts (an aerial tram, 4 High-Speed Quads, 6 Doubles), plus a 600-foot tunnel enclosing a one-way conveyor lift connecting Peruvian Gulch to Mineral Basin. The tunnel, the first of its kind in North America, allows easier access for beginners and intermediates to new terrain and for skier transport when winds require the closing of the aerial tram. The resort is in an isolated mountain setting that is a cozy, pedestrian village within rugged surroundings. Snowboarders are welcome here and have access to the entire area. **Ski magazine ranks Snowbird number 9 for Lifts, number 7 for Weather, number 5 for Terrain Variety, number 2 for Snow, and number 4 for Overall Satisfaction!**

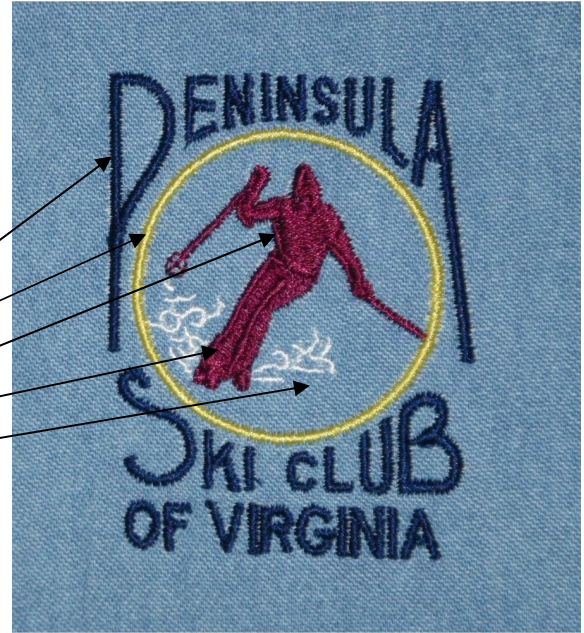
